

Weekend Day Trip: Family Safari



Adelaide Morialta Gumeracha Woodside Littlehampton Mt Barker Piccadilly Stirling Adelaide



From Adelaide, head East toward Norwood and start your morning with a trip to Morialta Conservation Park for a barbecue brekky and a hike among the waterfalls. www.parks.sa.gov.au/find-a-park

From here, head up Gorge Road to visit the world's biggest rocking horse at Gumeracha. The kids can climb to the very top of this Australian icon. www.thetoyfactory.com.au

Drive 15-minutes south through Lobethal to grab a well-deserved glass of vino and a delicious pizza at Barristers Block Wines – it's family friendly! www.barristersblock.com.au

Hop back in the car, and head to Four Oaks Farm. The kids will squeal with excitement at the chance to saddle up and ride a pony on a guided trail. www.fouroaksfarm.com.au

On your way past Mount Barker, pop in for a coffee and say hello at Newenham and Sales and Information Centre. You'll discover the beauty of calling this place home. www.newenham.com.au

Now for the really fun part, head back down the freeway and discover Woodhouse Activity Centre and their newest attraction, a 100m Tube Slide! www.woodhouse.org.au/activities/tubeslide
